DAY TO DAY DESCRIPTIONS

Day 1


Queen Alia Airport - King Hussein Bridge - Jerusalem (Pray at Al Aqsa)

Arrive in Amman, meet & assist at Queen Alia International Airport. Transfer to King Hussein Bridge, cross into Palestine. Enjoy a panoramic view of Jerusalem from Mount of Olives. Perform prayers at Al Aqsa Mosque.

"Glorified is He who took His servant by night from Al-Masjid Al-Haram to Al-Masjid Al-*Aqsa...* " (Holy Qur'an 17:1)

Overnight in Jerusalem.

- Meals: Lunch en route & Dinner in hotel.
- Distance/Time: Airport in Amman Jerusalem city (115 KM 5 Hours: Road & borders formalities)





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Day 2

Jerusalem (City Tour) - Nabi Mousa - King Hussein Bridge - Nabi Shu'aib - Amman

Tour the Old City of Jerusalem: Islamic Museum with ancient Qur'ans and Islamic arms.

Al-Buraq Wall (*Reference: Al-Isra' wal-Mi'raj*). Visit Omar Mosque, near the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, symbolizing peaceful coexistence. Explore Jerusalem's three quarters: Islamic, Christian, and Jewish — promoting interfaith respect and cultural understanding. Then continue to Nabi Mousa for a visit.

Return to Jordan via King Hussein Bridge. Visit shrines of noble Prophet Nabi Shu'aib (PBUH): Mentioned in the Qur'an as a prophet sent to the people of Madyan (Qur'an 7:85).

Overnight in Amman.

- Meals: Breakfast & Dinner in hotels. Lunch in local restaurant.
- Distance/Time: Jerusalem Shuaib Amman (145 KM 6 Hours: Road & border formalities)



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Day 3

Amman – Bilal ibn Rabah – Abdul Rahman ibn Awf - Ahl Al Kahf – Airport

Visit the shrine of Bilal ibn Rabah (RA): The first muezzin of Islam, who upheld the call to prayer under persecution. His unwavering faith reminds us of the power of spiritual resilience. Visit the shrine of Abdul Rahman ibn Awf (RA): One of the "Ashra Mubashreen" (the ten companions promised Paradise), a symbol of generosity and successful trade ethics in Islam. Visit Ahl Al-Kahf (The People of the Cave): Reference: Surah Al-Kahf (Qur'an 18). Reflect on faith of believing only in one God (ALLAH). Transfer to Queen Alia Airport for departure.

- Meals: Breakfast in hotel & Lunch Boxes en route.
- Distance/Time: Ahl Al Kahf site Airport (27 KM 0:35 Hours)





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
