DAY TO DAY DESCRIPTIONS

Day 1

Queen Alia Airport – Amman

Warm welcome by Al Athar representative at immigration upon your arrival to Queen Alia International Airport, efficient assistance with visa and luggage collection, then private transfer to your hotel in Amman. Evening at leisure for rest and reflection.

Overnight in Amman.

- Meals: Dinner in hotel.
- Distance/Time : Airport Amman (38 KM 00:40 Hours)











Amman - Nabi Shuaib - Dead Sea - Nabi Lut Cave - Mu'tah Battlefield - Al Mazar

Today trace the steps of two prophets and live one famous battlefield, begin your spiritual journey by visiting Maqam Nabi Shuaib: Honoring Prophet Shuʿayb (peace be upon him), mentioned 11 times in the Holy Quran. Continue along the scenic Dead Sea route to the Cave and Maqam of Nabi Lut (peace be upon him), the nephew of Prophet Ibrahim (peace be upon him). Visit the Lowest Museum on Earth, then ascend to Mu'tah Battlefield, scene of the heroic encounter between Muslim forces and Byzantines in 8 AH, reflecting on courage and sacrifice.

Pay respects at the **Maqamat of the Martyr Sahabah**: **Zaid bin Harithah** (may Allah be pleased with him), the beloved commander. **Ja'far bin Abi Talib** (may Allah be pleased with him), known for his steadfast faith. **Abdullah bin Rawahah** (may Allah be pleased with him), the inspiring poet-warrior.

Overnight in Amman.

Nabi Shuaib – Nabi Lut Cave (120 KM – 2 Hours)

Amman (Umayyad Palace) – The Blessed Tree – Al Azraq Castle – Ahl Al Kahf – Amman Downtown

After breakfast, explore **Amman Citadel**, visit **Umayyad Palace**: Overlooking the old city, then drive to **The Blessed Tree**, It is believed that Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) rested under this tree during his journey to Bilad al-Sham (Considering that this is Weak Hadith). Visit the nearby **Al Azraq Castle**, A desert fortress flourishing in the Umayyad period, with a rich history of resilience.

Late afternoon, return to Amman to witness the cave of **Ahl Al Kahf** (The Cave of the Sleepers): Mentioned in Surah Al-Kahf, a powerful reminder of monotheism faith and divine protection. "Or have you thought that the companions of the cave and the inscription were, among Our signs, a wonder?" — Surah Al-Kahf (18:9)

Before returning to your hotel, discover **the Downtown of Amman**, visit Al Husseini Mosque and explore the traditional markets, embracing local culture and craftsmanship.

Overnight in Amman.

- Meals: Breakfast in hotel. Lunch Boxes en route. Dinner in local restaurant.
- Distance/Time : Amman Blessed Tree (160 KM 2 Hours)













Amman- Maqamat (Derar, Abu Ubaidah, Shurhabil & Mu'adh) - Um Qais - Yarmouk Battlefield

After breakfast, explore the blessed Jordan Valley by visiting the Maqamat of distinguished Sahabah: Derar bin Al Azwar, renowned poet and valiant warrior. Abu Ubaidah Amer bin Al Jarrah, the "Trustee of the Ummah," praised by the Prophet (peace be upon him). Shurhabil bin Hasna, commander of the army during the conquest of Jordan. Mu'adh bin Jabal, known for his knowledge and participation in the Aqaba Allegiance. Proceed to Umm Qays (Gadara), enjoy panoramic views over Syria's Golan Heights, Lebanon's Mount Hermon, and Palestine's Sea of Galilee. Finally, Visit the historic Battlefield of Yarmouk, where Muslim forces achieved a decisive victory.

Amman – Maqam Abu Ubaidah (60 KM – 1:15 Hour) Maqam Abu Ubaidah – Um Qais (60 KM – 1:30 Hours) Yarmouk Battlefield – Amman (120 KM – 2 Hours)
