Day 1

Queen Alia Airport - Amman

Al Athar representative will happily meet you at immigration upon your arrival to Queen Alia International Airport, efficient assistance with visa and luggage collection, then private transfer to your hotel in Amman. Rest and prepare for your exciting journey ahead.

Amman city tour - Ahl El Kahf - Iraq Al Amir

After breakfast, Discover Amman's historical heart, start by panoramic views from Amman Citadel which contains Umayyad Palace, Byzantine Church, and the Temple of Hercules, then descend to the Roman Theatre: Still hosting cultural events today, from there walk through the old markets of Amman & Enjoy delicious local sweets (Gold Market, Kunafa Sweet, Vegetables Market,...), Continue to the modern Museum of Jordan to witness how Muslim Scholars contributed highly in the modern human civilization. End the tour of Amman at King Abdullah Mosque (Blue Mosque) for prayer and reflection.

Today you will also hear and feel the inspiring Quranic story of the young believers who slept for 300 years at **Ahl Al-Kahf** (The Cave of the Sleepers). Finally, explore **Iraq Al-Amir**, with its ancient caves and Qasr al-Abd, carved into the cliffs. Opportunity to interact with local craftswomen at Iraq Al-Amir Women's Cooperative, supporting local enterprise.

Amman - Madaba - Mount Nebo - Mu'tah - Al Mazar - Petra


Today you will taste the diversity in Joran's Culture, begin with **Madaba**, visit the Mosaics School, pass by the old market to St. George's Church to view the famous Mosaic Map of the Holy Land. Proceed to **Mount Nebo**, where Prophet Moses (peace be upon him) viewed the Promised Land. See ancient mosaics and reflect on the stories of the prophets. Feel the traditional life of the locals through **La Storia Museum**. In late afternoon, our journey continues southwards to the **Battlefield of Mu'tah**, Site of the historic battle between Muslims and the Byzantine Empire. At **Al Mazar** Reflect on the bravery of Zayd ibn Harithah, Ja'far ibn Abi Talib, and Abdullah ibn Rawahah (may Allah be pleased with them). Free time for prayers, later the paths leads us to Petra.

Overnight in Petra.

- Meals: Breakfast and Dinner in hotels. Lunch in local restaurant.

Al Mazar - Petra (150 KM - 2:30 Hours)















Full Day Exploration of Petra – Petra By Night

Celebrate the breathtaking city of **Petra**, begin with a short horseback ride, walk through the Siq, the narrow gorge leading to the Treasury. Discover tombs, temples, and carvings of the Nabateans. Pause for prayer time and lunch. Free time to explore at your own pace, you can reach up till the Monastery overlooking Wadi Araba (the southern part of Jordan Valley). After light dinner you can enjoy the breathtaking experience of **Petra By Night.**

Overnight in Petra.

Petra - Wadi Rum Adventure - Dead Sea

Early morning drive to **Wadi Rum**, the Valley of the Moon, enjoy an adventurous 4x4 jeep tour with local Bedouin drivers. Experience the stunning desert landscape where Prophet Saleh's people once lived. Pause for prayers and lunch. Free time to explore at your own pace — families can enjoy storytelling about Qawm Thamoud and their magnificent rock carvings, as mentioned in the Holy Quran.

Our adventure continues as we drive via Wadi Araba Road to the Dead Sea, the lowest spot on earth, full of Oxygen with amusing water activities for all ages.
