DAY TO DAY DESCRIPTIONS

Day 1

Airport – Amman

Arrival to Amman, Queen Alia International Airport. Warm meet & assist by Al Athar airport representative, then transfer to your hotel in Amman.

Overnight in Amman

Meals: Dinner in hotel.

Distance/Time: 38 KMS (40 Minutes)











Amman city tour

Your journey begins in the elegant western neighborhoods of Abdoun and Dabouq, where modern Amman reveals itself through graceful homes and leafy streets. At the Children's Museum and the Royal Automobile Museum, generations come together to marvel at innovation and legacy.

Soon, you'll step into a different world—one of serenity and history—at King Hussein Mosque and the Prophet's Museum. The road takes you further back in time to the hilltop Maqam of Sahabi Abdel Rahman bin Awf and the dazzling King Abdullah Mosque, before climbing up to the ancient Amman Citadel. From here, the city stretches in every direction layers of civilization whispering stories across millennia.

In the heart of downtown, the Roman Theatre echoes with faded applause as you stroll to the vibrant gold and vegetable markets. A humble yet unforgettable lunch awaits at Hashem Restaurant, followed by a sweet indulgence—kunafa from Habibah. The Jordan Museum brings the day full circle, and a leisurely walk down Rainbow Street at dusk closes your cultural symphony.

Overnight in Amman

Start time: 10:00 AM. - End time: 06:00 PM.

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner at the hotel + Lunch in local restaurant Downtown.

Distance/Time: City tour – Local movements only















Ajloun - Jilead

Start your day by heading north to the forested hills of Ajloun (76 KMS – 1 hour 30 minutes), where the mighty castle of Izz ad-Din Usama, nephew of Salahuddin Al Ayyubi, stands guard. As you wander its ancient corridors, you can almost hear the clang of armor and feel the pulse of faith that once defended this land.

From the heights, glide down by teleferic—soaring silently above the forest canopy—and into the heart of rural creativity. At the Ajloun Nature Reserve, you'll meet local artisans crafting soap, biscuits, and poetry with ink and brush. An old mosque offers quiet reflection before the warmth of a local family invites you in for lunch, afterwards you will enjoy the experience of picking fresh figs and grapes straight from the trees.

Later, a short journey (Ajloun – Jilead: 60 KMS – 1 hour 15 minutes) leads to a countryside retreat where children and adults alike enjoy pony rides and paintball—fun balanced with nature. Return to Amman with hearts full and cameras full.

Overnight in Amman

Start time: 08:00 AM. - End time: 08:00 PM.

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner at the hotel + Lunch with local family.

Jerash - Um Qais

The day unfolds in Jerash (51 KMS – 55 minutes), where the "Pompeii of the East" whispers tales of Roman glory. Before the grandeur of columns and theatres, find your moment of connection in a humble kitchen. Um Ali will teach you how to make Labaneh and Zebdeh Baladeyyeh—simple, sacred traditions passed down like family heirlooms.

Lunch is served at Beit Khair, a restaurant whose proceeds support orphanages, where every bite carries a story of community uplift. The journey continues north to Um Qais (70 KMS – 1 hour 30 minutes), where black basalt ruins overlook the Sea of Galilee, the Golan Heights, and Yarmouk River—three countries meeting beneath your feet.

As the sun sets, stories of ancient philosophers and Islamic scholars blend with the wind. Return to Amman, where dinner at Tawaheen El Hawa closes this day of wonder.

Overnight in Amman

Start time: 08:00 AM. - End time: 08:00 PM.

Meals: Breakfast at the hotel + Lunch & Dinner in local restaurants.













Salt (El Khader) – Nabi Youshaa – Nabi Ayyoub – Nabi Shuaib

You'll begin today in the peaceful old town of Salt (30 KMS – 45 minutes), where colorful homes and narrow lanes tell stories of harmony between faiths. Walking the Harmony Trail feels like stepping into a neighbourhood where everyone is family. At the Holy Land Institute for the Deaf, you'll meet inspiring people who support local community.

In a cozy home, a local family welcomes you to share a homemade lunch. The smell of traditional dishes fills the air as laughter and stories are exchanged around the table.

The journey continues to visit the resting places of prophets Youshaa, Ayyoub, and Shuaib (Salt – Nabi Shuaib: 40 KMS – 50 minutes). These quiet places feel calm and spiritual. As the sun sets, dinner is served overlooking Amman from Wild Jordan, where the city lights sparkle below.

Overnight in Amman

Start time: 08:00 AM. - End time: 07:30 PM.

Meals: Breakfast at the hotel + Lunch with local family & Dinner in local restaurants.













Sahaba (Dearar-Abu Ubaidah-Shurhabil-Moath) -Battlefields (Tabqat fahl-Yarmouk)

Today takes you through the Jordan Valley to the land where great companions of the Prophet (PBUH) lived and were laid to rest. Starting from Amman to Abu Ubaidah Magam (65 KMS – 1 hour 10 minutes), you'll visit the peaceful shrines of Dirar, Shurhabil, and Moath bin Jabal. The stories of their bravery in spreading Islam are told not just in books, but in the very air here.

From there, travel to the historic battlefield sites of Tabqat Fahel and Yarmouk (Abu Ubaidah - Yarmouk: 60 KMS - 1 hour 15 minutes), where you'll walk in the footsteps of Muslim warriors who changed the course of history with faith and courage.

Lunch will be served in a local restaurant before heading back to Amman. The day may be long, but the memories will stay with you.

Overnight in Amman

Start time: 08:00 AM. - End time: 07:30 PM.

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner at the hotel + Lunch in local restaurant.















Ahl El Kahf – Friday Prayer – Qusair Amra – Blessed Tree

Begin with a visit to the Cave of the Sleepers (Ahl El Kahf), a site mentioned in the Holy Quran. As you walk into the cave, it feels like time has stood still, letting you reflect on faith and patience.

At noon, take part in the Friday prayer at the beautiful King Abdullah Mosque in Amman, often called the Blue Mosque. Standing shoulder to shoulder with fellow worshippers, the atmosphere is both peaceful and powerful.

After prayers, head out into the desert to visit Qusair Amra (Amman – Qusair Amra: 85 KMS – 1 hour 20 minutes), a UNESCO heritage site. Its ancient walls are decorated with drawings that tell old stories. From there, the road leads to the Blessed Tree (Qusair Amra – Blessed Tree: 90 KMS – 1 hour 30 minutes), where the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) once rested (Considering this is a Weak Hadith).

Overnight in Amman

Start time: 09:00 AM. - End time: 07:30 PM.

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner at the hotel + Lunch box en route.













Um El Rassas – Makawer (Bani Hamidah) – Kerak – Mu'tah – Mazar - Petra

Your journey today begins at Um El Rassas (75 KMS – 1 hour 20 minutes), a quiet place where ancient churches and mosaics lie beneath open skies. It feels like walking through a forgotten village frozen in time.

Next is Makawer (40 KMS – 50 minutes), where you'll stand on the hilltop believed to be where Prophet Yahya (John the Baptist) was beheaded. The views stretch endlessly across hills and valleys—it's a powerful spot for reflection. Here also, the Bani Hamida women's project welcomes you to see local crafts and meet the women keeping traditions alive.

You'll then visit the battlefield of Mu'tah (Makawer – Karak: 38 KMS – 45 minutes) and the shrines of the beloved Sahaba—Zaid ibn Harithah, Ja'far ibn Abi Talib, and Abdullah ibn Rawahah (Karak – Mazar – Petra: 145 KMS – 2 hours 30 minutes). Here, history comes alive through bravery and faith.

Overnight in Petra

Start time: 08:00 AM. - End time: 07:00 PM.

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner at the hotel + Lunch in local restaurant.













Visit Petra (Horse riding) – Petra by Night


Today is all about Petra, the rose-red city carved into the rocks. As you walk through the narrow Siq, the famous Treasury appears like a secret being revealed. You'll explore the ancient tombs, temples, and streets, learning how this hidden city once thrived with life, trade, and culture. A short horse ride takes you part of the way, just as travelers did centuries ago.

After a full day, rest and return again at night. Petra by Night is a magical experience. Lit by candlelight and accompanied by soft music, the stone walls glow as stars shine above. It's a quiet, peaceful moment to end a powerful day.

Overnight in Petra

Start time: 07:00 AM. - End time: 10:00 PM.

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner at the hotel + Lunch in local restaurant.















Petra- Aqaba (Submarine & Aqabawi)- Wadi Rum (4*4 Jeep & Stargaszing)

Leave Petra and drive to the coastal city of Agaba (125 KMS – 2 hours), where the sea is clear and full of life. A ride in a glass-bottom submarine lets you see colorful fish and coral without getting wet. Afterward, you'll take part in the Aqabawi experience—a hands-on way to discover local culture through food and crafts.

Next, the journey takes you to the desert of Wadi Rum (Aqaba – Wadi Rum: 70 KMS – 1 hour). You'll ride in a 4x4 jeep through wide, open spaces and towering red rocks. As the sun sets, the sky turns pink and orange—it's a view you'll never forget.

Dinner is served under a Bedouin tent, followed by a stargazing session with Rum Sky. With no city lights, the stars feel close enough to touch.

Overnight in Wadi Rum

Start time: 07:30 AM. - End time: 10:00 PM.

Meals: Breakfast at hotel+ Lunch with local family + Dinner under Bedouin Tent.













Wadi Rum (Camel ride) - Nabi Lut - Dead Sea

Wake up before sunrise for a camel ride in the quiet desert. The air is cool and fresh, and the rising sun paints the sky in soft colors. After breakfast at camp, drive through Wadi Araba to visit the cave of Prophet Lut (Wadi Rum – Nabi Lut Cave: 180 KMS – 2 hours 40 minutes), where stories of guidance and faith are remembered. Nearby, visit the lowest museum on Earth, a small but rich place that shows the natural and cultural history of this unique region. Continue your journey to the Dead Sea (Nabi Lut – Dead Sea: 60 KMS – 1 hour). Arrive at your hotel by early afternoon, just in time to relax by the water.

Overnight at the Dead Sea

Start time: 05:00 AM. - End time: 2:30 PM.

Meals: Breakfast at the camp + Lunch & Dinner in the Hotel.















Free day at the Dead Sea

After days filled with discovery, today is your chance to simply relax. The Dead Sea, known for its healing waters and peaceful views, invites you to float and let go. There's no pressure to rush—just take your time, enjoy a slow swim, and treat yourself to a natural mud bath.

The rest of the day is yours. Whether you choose to read by the pool, explore the resort, or watch the sunset reflect over the still water, this is your moment to unwind and reflect.

Overnight at the Dead Sea

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner at the hotel.













Dead Sea - Mount Nebo - Amman shopping

After a calm morning, head to Mount Nebo (Dead Sea – Mount Nebo: 35 KMS – 45 minutes), where it is believed Prophet Musa (Moses) stood and viewed the Promised Land. From the top, the view is wide and peaceful—you can see all the way to the Jordan Valley. A visit to the La Storia museum nearby brings history to life through interactive exhibits.

Next, return to Amman (Mount Nebo – Amman: 42 KMS – 50 minutes) for some shopping time. Whether it's handmade crafts, spices, or gifts for loved ones, this is a great moment to take a piece of Jordan home with you.

Your farewell dinner is served in Beit Nemeh, located within the historic Amman Citadel. As you dine, enjoy a panoramic view of the city you've come to know and love.

Overnight in Amman

Start time: 01:00 PM. - End time: 08:30 PM.

Meals: Breakfast at hotel + Lunch in Mount Nebo + Farwell dinner at Beit Nemeh
