# Day 1 FRIDAY 20.02.2026

# Airport – Amman

Arrival to Amman, Queen Alia International Airport. Warm meet & assist by Al Athar airport representative, then transfer to your hotel in Amman.

Overnight in Amman.

### Day 2 SATURDAY 21.02.2026

### Amman Castle - Ahl el Kahf - Blessed Tree - Azraq Wetland Reserve - Amman

We begin our day in **Amman**, Jordan's vibrant capital, with a tour that blends the city's modern pulse and deep Islamic heritage. Visit the **King Abdullah Mosque**, known for its grand blue dome and tranquil prayer space, visit **the Islamic Center**, followed by a stop at the **Amman Citadel**, where the **Umayyad Palace** overlooks **the Roman Theatre**. Our next stop is at **Ahl El Kahf**, the site believed to be the **Cave of the Sleepers** mentioned in Surah Al-Kahf — a serene and spiritually moving place. Continue our journey (2 hrs drive), to the **Blessed Tree (Al-Buqayawiyya Tree)**, under which **Prophet Muhammad (PBUH)** is said to have rested as a young boy during a trade journey with his uncle (Taking into consideration this is a Weak Hadith). In the late afternoon visit **Azraq Wetland Reserve** (1 hr drive), a peaceful sanctuary where **casual birdwatchers** might spot migratory birds and the rare **Pharaoh Eagle-Owl**. Finally drive back to Amman.

Overnight in Amman.

### Day 3 SUNDAY 22.02.2026

#### Amman - Mu'tah - Al Mazar - Dana Nature Reserve - Petra

After breakfast, we journey south toward **Mu'tah and Al-Mazar** (2 hrs drive), a deeply sacred places. It was here that the historic **Battle of Mu'tah** took place, and we visit the serene shrines of **Zaid ibn Harithah**, **Ja'far ibn Abi Talib**, and **Abdullah ibn Rawahah** (**RA**) — companions of the Prophet (PBUH) who were martyred here. Lunch is a warm, authentic meal hosted by a local Jordanian family — a chance to enjoy halal food and hospitality having Jordan's Traditional Meal **Mansaf**. We then head to **Dana Nature Reserve** (2 hrs drive), where dramatic cliffs and wide skies offer a breathtaking backdrop for **light birdwatching**. You may catch a glimpse of the soaring **Griffon Vulture** or the graceful **Short-Toed Eagle**, while Walking along beginner-friendly trails. By late afternoon, we travel onward to **Petra** (1 hr drive), where we check in to our hotel and prepare for the next day's adventure.

Overnight in Petra.

Start time: 07:30 AM. - End time: 07:00 PM.

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner at the hotel + Lunch with local family.















### Day 4 MONDAY 23.02.2026

# Petra Visit – Wadi Rum (Stargazing)

After a nourishing breakfast, we step into the timeless wonder of **Petra**, where towering rose-colored rocks hide an ancient Nabatean city. Walk the famed **Siq canyon** as sunlight pierces through narrow stone walls, revealing the majestic **Treasury** — a sight that feels almost spiritual in its stillness. Your local guide will share stories that link Petra to early Islamic history and Arab trade routes. After late lunch, we drive south toward **Wadi Rum**, known in the Qur'an as a place resembling "valleys with lofty mountains." This vast redsand desert has a powerful serenity, perfect for reflecting on the wonders of creation. As we arrive, we're welcomed with warm Bedouin hospitality and settle into our **Halal-friendly desert camp**, where prayer spaces are prepared. After dinner, enjoy stargazing in silence under one of the clearest night skies in the world — a perfect moment for both reflection and awe.

Overnight in Wadi Rum (Camp).

## Day 5 TUESDAY 24.02.2026


# Wadi Rum (4\*4 Adventure) – Agaba Bird Observatory – Ayla Feather Trail

Wake to the cool stillness of dawn in Wadi Rum and join the early Fajr prayer in the desert's peaceful embrace. Experience an **amazing Sunrise**. After breakfast, we jump into 4x4 vehicles for a thrilling yet gentle desert tour, riding across the sands where dramatic rock formations rise like stone castles. We then travel to **Aqaba**, Jordan's coastal gem, with a short and scenic drive (1 hour). Upon arrival, explore the city's market and enjoy a seafood lunch. In the afternoon, we visit the **Aqaba Bird Observatory**, a hidden sanctuary at the edge of the city. Here, casual birdwatchers may spot species like the **Arabian Babbler**, herons, and seasonal migratory birds. We end the day on the tranquil **Ayla Feather Trail**, a relaxing walk by landscaped lagoons designed to attract birdlife. Tonight's stay is in a halal-friendly hotel.

Overnight in Aqaba.

## Day 6 WEDNESDAY 25.02.2026

# Agaba - Nabi Lut Cave - The Dead Sea (Free Time)

Drive northwards of Aqaba through the Jordan Valley, tracing a route used by prophets, until we reach the **Cave of Prophet Lut (AS)** (2:30 hrs drive) — a site of historical and Qur'anic significance near Ghor Al-Safi. The nearby museum provides insight into the ancient civilizations and spiritual legacy of the region. From there, we continue to the **Dead Sea** (1 hr drive), the lowest point on Earth. Check into your **halal-friendly resort**. The rest of the day is free to relax and float in the salty waters — a natural experience that soothes both body and soul. Many guests enjoy this time for quiet dhikr, reflection, or simply taking in the miraculous setting with **a great Sunset** panoramic view.

Overnight in the Dead Sea.

### Day 7 THURSDAY 26.02.2026

# The Dead Sea – Nabi Shuaib – Amman Shopping

After a peaceful morning of rest or sunrise prayer by the sea, we depart for **Nabi Shuaib's shrine**, located in a green valley overlooking the Jordan Rift. This is a revered spiritual site, honoring Prophet Shuaib (AS), and offers a moment of spiritual grounding before the journey ends. We then head back to **Amman** (1 hour drive) for some last-minute exploration and shopping. Visit downtown's vibrant markets for modest clothing, perfumes, prayer items, and gifts. You'll also have time for Jummah or other prayers at nearby mosques, such as the **Grand Husseini Mosque**, in the heart of old Amman. This final evening offers a reflective closure to the journey — combining nature, culture, and faith into a meaningful whole. Your farewell dinner is served in Beit Nemeh, located within the historic Amman Citadel. As you dine in Beit Nemeh, you will be supporting great human cause and at the same time enjoying a panoramic view of the city you've come to know and love.
